The 45th Annual Alexandra Festival is coming up fast! This year's event will run from 11 AM to 5 PM on Saturday May 25, 2019. Both the large and small stages will have live entertainment all day. We won't be having a road closure this year or using the park across the street.

Our vendor emphasis is on artisans and crafters, rather than on mass-market goods. Please be very specific on your registration form about the goods you want to sell. As always, registration is on a first come-first served basis, and we will be restricting the number of vendors selling similar items, so again, please make sure we know exactly what you are planning to sell.

Please note:

- Spots are 10' x 10'
- Please bring your own table, shelter, extension cords, display materials, etc.
- The festival takes place rain or shine
- Set up begins at 9 AM on Saturday the 25th

Once approved, artisans must submit the \$90 registration fee to secure a spot. The fee includes individual Alex House membership. (*Registration fee is non-refundable*)

If you are selling food of any kind, including 'farmer's market' type goods, you are required to obtain a permit from Fraser Health. This includes jams, jellies, pies, etc. as well as food that is considered to be a meal.
