The Summer Camp Coordinator is a professional staff member of the Association of Neighbourhood Houses BC. Counselors are mature, capable, enthusiastic university students trained to provide effective leadership and care. A First Aid attendant is in residence.

Our catering staff provide three healthy nutritionally balanced meals daily as well as tasty snacks.

Dates and Fees

#1 - Camp Away: June 17-21

Our calm n' steady camp for supported adults who want a relaxing week away, this camp is open to adults with mental health needs and/or developmental disabilities.

#2 - Camp Fun Times: June 24-28

This is a more 'high spirited' camp for adults with developmental disabilities.

Program

A wide variety of activities and programs are provided during camp including talent night, bingo, dances, picnics, beach fun, out-trips, cooking, arts and crafts, campfire, and special events every evening.

Our student counselors are responsible for the care, safety and orientation of their campers with a 7-1 ratio.

Please contact us if you are uncertain whether your camper will be comfortable with the ratio.

Campers are housed in groups and sleep in cabins and rooms without their counselors.

Facilities

Updated facilities include Alex Hall, the Lodge, and the Dining Hall for a traditional camp feel.

Accommodations

One bungalow divided into separate sleeping rooms

Seven cabins each accommodating up to 8 people

Lodge to accommodate staff and campers.
